It was our pleasure to organize the "22nd Anniversary of Korean War Veterans Appreciation Luncheon" to honour and remember Korean War Veterans on November 9th at the Royal Canadian Airforce Association 447 Wing in Mount Hope, Ontario. This year, we commemorated the "70th Anniversary of the Korean War Armistice" and the "60th Anniversary of Canada and Korea Diplomatic Relations". Over 100 invited guests attended the event including Consul General Deuk Hwan Kim, Donna Skelly, MPP, Frank Bergon, Chief of Hamilton Police, Ryan Diodati, Deputy Police Chief, WWII and Korean War Veterans, other Canadian Veterans and their family members.

Prime Minister Justin Trudeau sent his personal greeting letter stating that "This annual event honours Canadian Veterans who fought during the Korean War. With this year marking the "70th anniversary of the Korean War Armistice and the 60th anniversary of diplomatic relations between Canada and the Republic of Korea, this event also provides a wonderful opportunity to reflect upon the many contributions that generations of Canadians of Korean origin have made to our country".


26,791 Canadian served during the Korea Korean War (June 25, 1950 - July 27, 1953) and an additional 7,000 served during the UN Peace Keeping Mission (1953-1955). 516 died, 1,558 wounded. 16 United Nations forces fought during the Korean War.

Consul Deuk Hwan Kim presented the "Ambassador for Peace Medal" to Corporal (Ret'd) Euclide Edward Laporte who served with the Royal Canadian Regiment (RCR) 3rd Battalion and Able Seaman (Ret'd) Henry Stanley Barnes who served with the Royal Canadian Navy HMCS Haida. Since he is deceased his son Stanley Barnes who also served with the Royal Canadian Navy for 15 years received the Ambassador for Peace Medal on behalf of his father.

The "Act of Remembrance" was recited by Romeo Daley, past President of Korea Veterans Association of Canada Unit 15, Niagara Falls. "Last Post" and "Reveille" were played by David Baldry. "Lament" was played by Mike Cuffe, a Bagpiper and Chairman of the Royal Canadian Air Force Association 447 Wing.

Sofia Spilberg, a very talented Violin Artist played various songs, Paula Ann Simon, played her Flute, Sunja Lee sang "You Raised Me Up" and Korean folk song "Arirang". Bok Sil Shin sang various songs and Mike Cuffe played "Amazing Grace" with his bagpipes. Everyone enjoyed the delicious luncheon and entertainment.


